








### **REASSIGNING THE MULTI-FUNCTION (M1-M6) MAPPING**

2. Press the button you want to assign to it.






Remap Successful (Blinking White)

### USING THE SENSITIVITY CLUTCH FUNCTION


Holding down the assigned button will lower the chosen analog stick's sensitivity by up to 50%.

The Razer Wolverine V3 Tournament Edition requires minimum maintenance to keep it in optimum condition. Once a month we recommend you unplug the device and clean it using a soft cloth or cotton to prevent dirt buildup. Do not use soap or harsh cleaning agents.
